OGDEN, UTAH CHOSEN FOR NEW PLANT

Brundidge, AL / Southern Classic Food Group, L.L.C., a food manufacturer supplying various products to the retail, foodservice and industrial food segments, has announced construction of a second facility to be located in Ogden, Utah. This facility will represent a major step forward, allowing the company the opportunity to more efficiently service the western U.S. with the products that Southern Classic manufactures.

This initial facility will consist of 75,000 sq ft. of production and warehousing with plans to double that later on. During the first phase, the business will produce about 40 million pounds annually with plans to eventually produce in excess of 100 million pounds of various food products. Currently Southern Classic makes an assortment of products including vinegars, syrups, dressings, sauces, marinades, dessert toppings, drink mixers and has recently committed to begin production of single serve beverage products.

The current plan includes beginning to hire associates next spring with production activities beginning during the summer of 2008. Current estimate of employment in 2008 will be 30 – 40 highly motivated individuals with plans to grow to nearly 100 as the company continues to implement its plan. Employees will be needed for production, quality assurance, maintenance, sanitation, administrative and warehousing activities.

“This new facility will create the opportunity to continue our growth plan,” said Chuck Caraway, President and Managing Member. “We expect this will be a valuable step forward for some of our existing customers and at the same time put us in position to develop new relationships.”
